Dear Councillors,

I have attached a drawing showing the latest proposals for the tree removal and re-surfacing work at Bingham Market Place. Since my last email we have dug some trial pits to assess the root growth of trees. Unfortunately the roots of the trees are more restricted than previously thought and are almost entirely confined to the 3cm sand bed on which the slabs are laid. As a result of this we have taken the decision that all the large trees need to be removed as increased disruption of slabs is inevitable and as the trees get bigger the chance of die back in periods of drought will increase.

I have considered the comments the Town Council made about protecting the areas around trees with benches to allow them to be retained. Whilst this would limit pedestrian access to the most disrupted areas of paving, it would have an impact on the number of market stalls which could be accommodated and the Council is keen to ensure the market remains a thriving feature of the town and is not affected by the work.

At present 2 species of replacement trees have been chosen. Ginkgo Bilboa is a relic of the dinosaur era, but is now popular in urban planting as it is a tough, deep rooted tree. I have also chosen a variation of the native Field Maple, where the new growth has a subtle crimson flush which should provide interest throughout the summer.

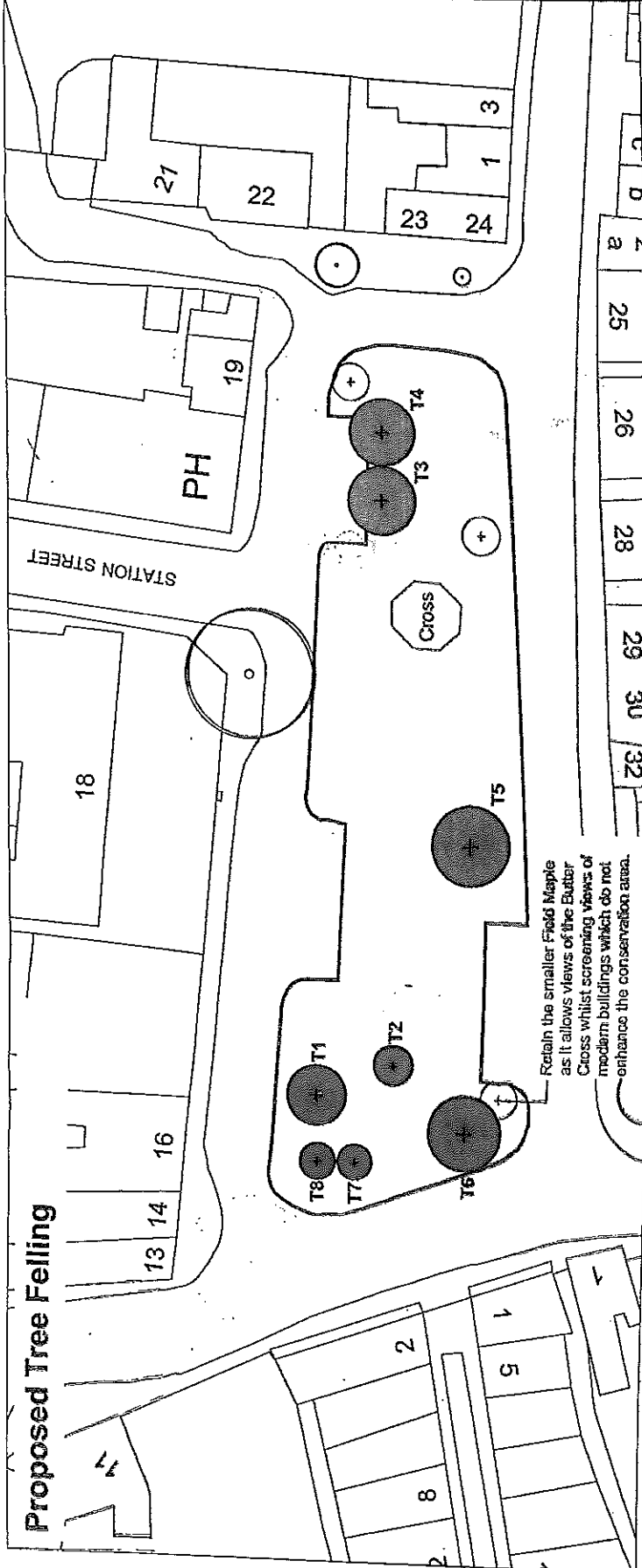

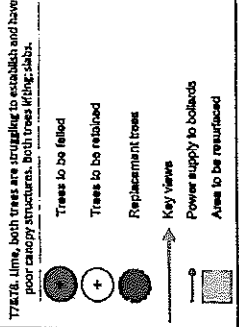

# Proposed Tree Felling

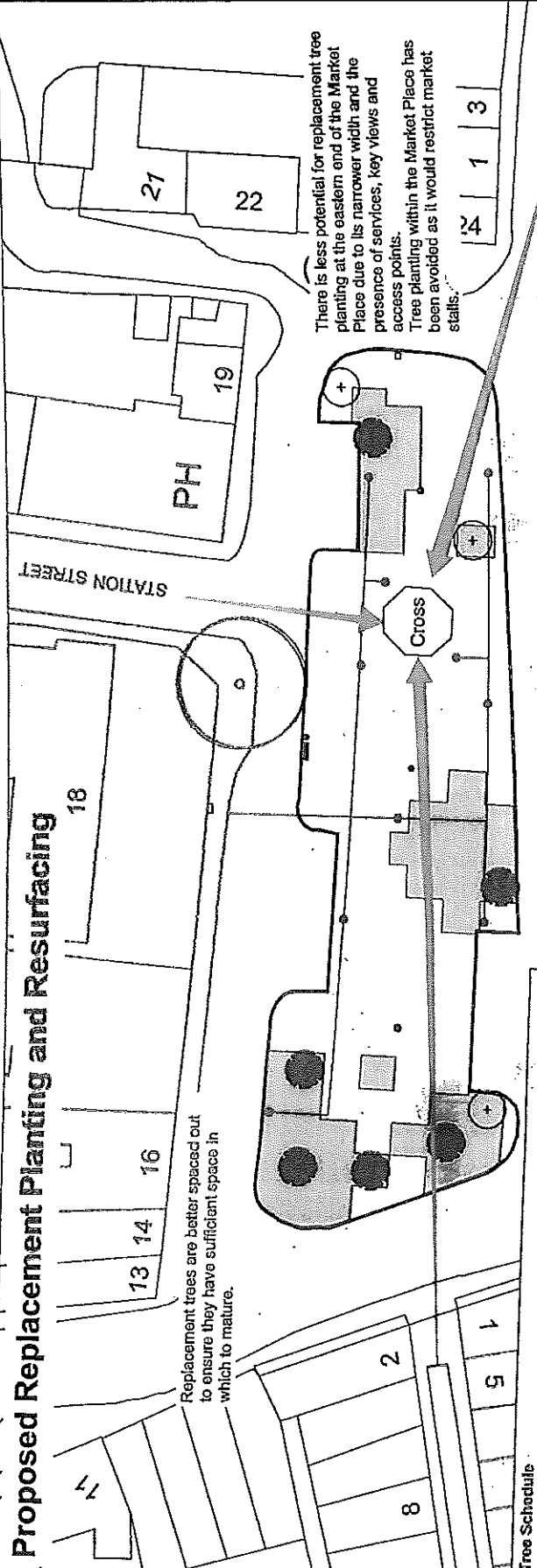


Retain the smaller Field Maple as it allows views of the Butter Cross whilst screening views of modern buildings which do not enhance the conservation area.

- Notes:**
- T1. London Plane. Acute forks and causing ornamental disruption.
  - T2. London Plane. Suffered severe die back in 2010. Poor shape and form.
  - T3. Horse Chestnut with an acute fork and bleaching canker recommended for felling in recent tree survey. Extensive disruption of slabs.
  - T4. Horse Chestnut. Good shape and health, but roots blocked drains. Extensive disruption of slabs.
  - T5. London Plane, reasonable tree, suffered some dieback in 2010. Extensive lifting of slabs.
  - T7. London Plane, the best tree, but causing extensive lifting of slabs.
  - T7&T8. Lime, both trees are struggling to establish and have poor canopy structures. Both trees lifting slabs.



# Proposed Replacement Planting and Resurfacing



Replacement trees are better spaced out to ensure they have sufficient space in which to mature.

There is less potential for replacement tree planting at the eastern end of the Market Place due to its narrower width and the presence of services, key views and access points. Tree planting within the Market Place has been avoided as it would restrict market stalls.

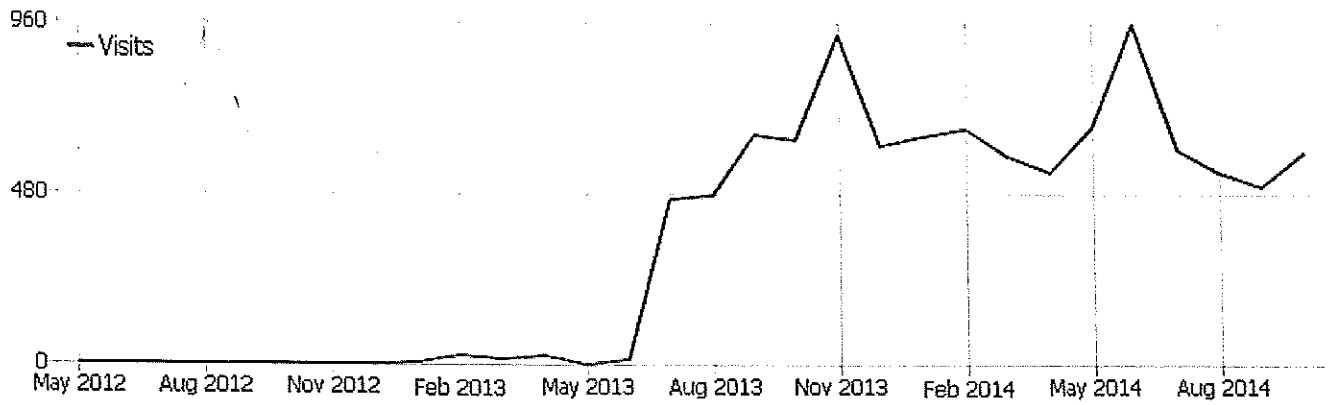

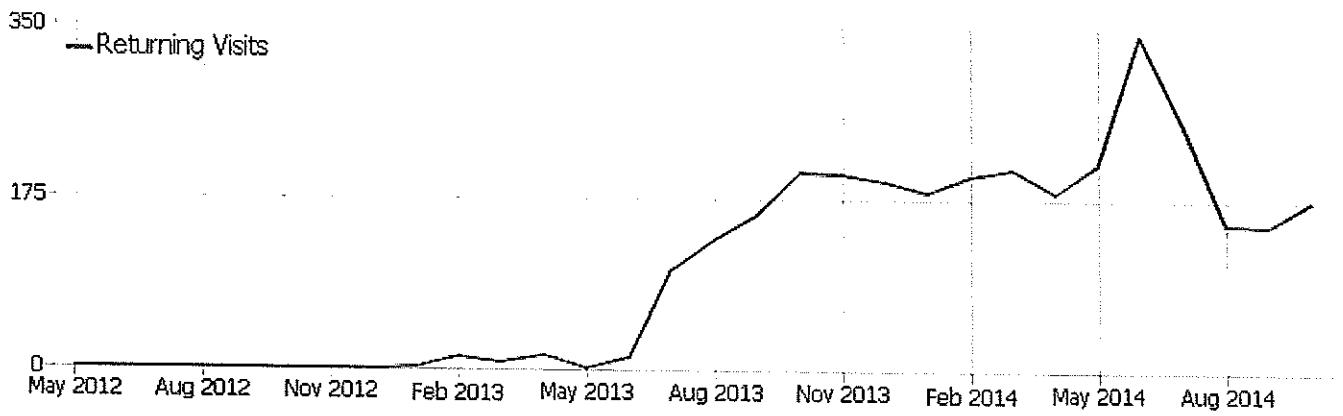
