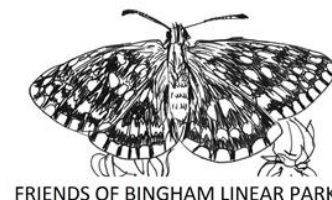

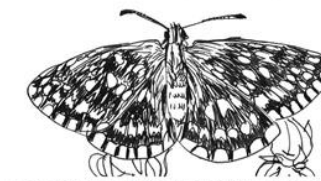

LICENSING ACT 2003: APPLICATIONS FOR LIQUOR LICENCES

The Alcohol and Entertainments Licensing Committee of the Council agreed to inform elected members and the appropriate Parish/Town Councils of applications received by the Councils Licensing Service under the Licensing Act 2003 in respect of new premises or variations of existing premises in their area. The Council new Licensing system allows you to view all aspects of the application on line. You should follow the link below, click on Premises Register tick the box next to the wording 'Show only premises with applications that can have representations made against them' and press search. This will reveal the premises, and by clicking on the premises you will be able to see the full details of the application. <https://licensing.rushcliffe.gov.uk>



NOTES ON MAKING REPRESENTATIONS:

The Licensing Act 2003 is underpinned by the four licensing objectives:

The prevention of crime and disorder
Public safety
The prevention of public nuisance
The protection of children from harm

The four areas covered for licensing purposes are:

The sale of alcohol by retail
The provision of regulated entertainment
The provision of late night refreshment
The supply of alcohol by or on behalf of a club

When an application is made for a new premises licence or to vary a current licence the applicant must submit the application to the responsible authorities (see below), place a notice in a newspaper that circulates in the area and place an advert at the premises in question. The Licensing Service cannot inform local residents as with planning applications, and neither will the applicant.

*Any objections to applications **must** be based on one or more of the above licensing objectives in order to be valid, and not, for example because someone thinks there are too many licences premises in an area.*

Those parties who can make representations are split into two groups:

The responsible authorities: *Police, Fire, Trading Standards, Safeguarding Children Board, Health and Safety, Planning, Health Bodies, Environmental Health and the Licensing Authority.*

Other persons: *This term replaces interested parties as from **25th April 2012**. From this date ‘**other person**’ means persons who live, or are involved in a business, who are likely to be affected by the application no matter where they resident. This was previously only persons who lived in the vicinity. The term other persons will now include Parish Councils.*

Any objections to the applications must be made in writing to the Licensing Service within the 28 day period set for this purpose. If valid objections are received a hearing before the Alcohol and Entertainments Sub Committee will be arranged and those parties objecting will be invited to attend together with any person representing them. The hearing will normally take place with a further 28 days of the end of the initial period.
