## **BINGHAM TOWN COUNCIL 2020 INITIATIVE**

At the last Council meeting, Councillors agreed to re-start the Town Plan project that was put on hold for two years, due to delays in major strategic decisions by others. Bingham Town Council will play a major role in influencing and delivering specific community projects that can be achieved if Section 106 planning gain funds are available to the town within the next few years. The Bingham 2020 project will involve consulting residents on their wishes and priorities for the town and local neighbourhoods, which will assist Bingham Town Council and other local authorities in local community decision making. The working group will be chaired by the Town Mayor, currently Cllr. Mrs. T.Kerry.
