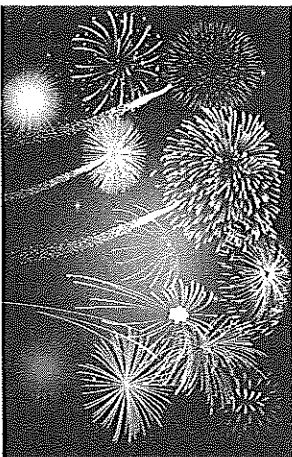
BINGHAM CEMETERY

PROPOSALS FOR REMEDIAL WORK BINGHAM MARKET PLACE

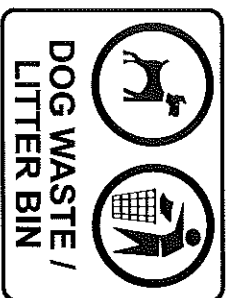

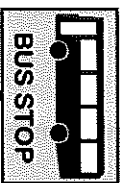
LINEAR WALK LITTER/DOG BINS

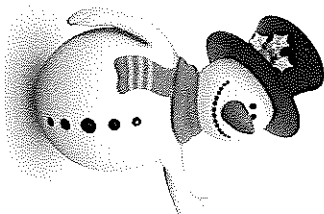
ADDITIONAL BUS STOPS ON MILL HILL ROAD AND TYTHBY ROAD

Notts. County Council propose installing 2 new bus stops (Both Ways poles) as follows:



1. Mill Hill Road – opposite junction of Meadowsweet Hill, with the bus stop at the rear of the footway.
2. Langar Road – opposite the junction of Langar Road, with the bus stop at the rear of the footway.

CHRISTMAS FAIR 5th December 2014 5pm – 8pm



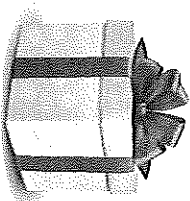
Planning for the Christmas Fair to be held on the Market Place are well underway. If anyone would like to assist with the decorating of Santa's Grotto please contact the office.
