#### **PARKING WORKING GROUP**

The Town Council continues to pursue a long term solution to parking with the 'Old Allotment Site' identified as a suitable site for a new long stay car park. Negotiations continue with 'The Crown', Rushcliffe Borough Council, Nottinghamshire County Council and Network Rail to facilitate this.

The recent parking order will put into place the principle of timed parking and charges. A recommendation has been put forward from BTC for 3hrs. maximum stay in Newgate Street car park with Union Street and Needham Street being long stay car parks. Negotiations are ongoing with Rushcliffe Borough Council on this matter.

#### **HOUSE NAMES**


