<u>RUSHCLIFFE AREA – NOTTINGHAM ROAD, BINGHAM - BUS STOP CLEARWAYS – NO STOPPING, AT ANY TIME, EXCEPT BUSES</u>

Via East Midlands Ltd, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, is proposing that the following location below is to be formalised as an enforceable marked bus stop clearway and is shown on the attached site notice: -

Nottingham Road, Bingham - No Stopping At Any Time, except buses

• RU 0533 – in the lay-by outside numbers 5 - 13 (opposite Chestnut Avenue)

It is proposed that the existing wooden shelter be replaced with a new polycarbonate shelter with solid black panels at the rear to maintain privacy for the properties. It is also planned to install a new fence around the boundary of the new shelter to separate the gardens form the bus shelter.

The County Council works closely with all public transport operators across the County to identify bus stops that suffer from inconsiderate parking. At the location listed above, a new bus stop clearway is to be installed that prohibit other vehicles from parking or waiting in the bus stop at the times specified and will be clearly identified with new road markings and signage. The main benefits of bus stop clearways are to:

- Help the bus align with the kerb to enable better access for disabled passengers and pushchair users;
- Ease congestion as a correctly aligned bus will not block the road for other road users;
- Ensure that bus drivers discharge their duty to drop passengers off on the kerb and not on the road;
- Ensure that bus services operate on time and are not unnecessarily delayed.

Before proceeding further with the bus stop clearways, I wish to consider the views of residents and organisations who may be interested in this matter. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals and if they cannot be resolved, they will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time. Any observations on these proposals should reach me in writing by **24**th **September 2021**. Any details you provide may be shared with Nottinghamshire County Council as appropriate.
