(costing's/quotes to be included)	To celebrate our 40 th Anniversary we plan to hold a Celebration party on 13 th September at the Methodist Church Hall. Over 100 people are being invited but not all expected to attend. There will be entertainment, speeches and a buffet. A budget is including the commission of a new website and the launch of a podcast. The contents of the audio magazine each month will be posted onto the podcast to open the channel for further membership, outside of our current remit.
Is the group making a financial contribution or providing evidence of any fundraising	We fund raise all year round. The last coffee morning and book sale in November last year raised £265. The Strawberry Tea will take place in July of this year. Last year that raised £247. We also have a "Friends of " which raises an average annual donation of £400. What we are not able to raise from grants will be supported by our current account.
Provide information on the benefit to Bingham residents if an award was made and an approx. number benefitting	We have an existing community of Listeners who access BADAM via a monthly CD delivered to their door. We will continue to support this in addition to the Podcast. Any new users will be able to request a CD if this medium is more accessible for them and our aim is to continue to provide these for free. Expanding our listener base in Bingham will bring isolated older people back into the community that they used to belong to before their mobility prevented their participation.
Details of other grants applied for or awarded to the group over the last twelve months	All Rushcliffe Borough Councillors will be approached to make a donation. Plus the Rotary Club have committed to supporting us as they do every year.
